3. Jake picked 5 apples, 3 oranges, and 4 bananas from the fruit stand. How many pieces of fruit did he pick in all?

4. On Monday, Sam read 4 pages. On Tuesday, he read 7 pages. On Wednesday, he read 3 pages. How many pages did Sam read in all?

5. There are 6 children on the swings, 5 children on the slide, and 2 children on the seesaw. How many children are on the playground in all?

6. Lily put 4 stickers on her notebook, 3 stickers on her folder, and 6 stickers on her backpack. How many stickers did she use in all?

7. A farmer has 5 cows, 4 pigs, and 7 chickens. How many farm animals does the farmer have in all?

8. Tom has 2 toy cars, 8 toy trucks, and 4 toy trains. How many toys does Tom have in all?

9. Emma baked 6 chocolate cookies, 5 vanilla cookies, and 3 peanut butter cookies. How many cookies did she bake in all?

10. There are 4 butterflies on a flower, 3 bees in the garden, and 5 ladybugs on a leaf. How many insects and bugs are there in all?

11. Carlos scored 7 points in the first game, 4 points in the second game, and 5 points in the third game. How many points did he score in all?

12. A bookshelf has 3 chapter books, 6 picture books, and 4 comic books. How many books are on the shelf in all?

13. Anna found 5 shells on Monday, 3 shells on Tuesday, and 8 shells on Wednesday. How many shells did she find in all?

14. There are 2 red fish, 7 blue fish, and 4 orange fish in the tank. How many fish are in the tank in all?

15. Ben put 6 grapes, 4 strawberries, and 3 blueberries in his bowl. How many pieces of fruit are in his bowl in all?

16. There are 5 birds in a tree, 6 birds on a fence, and 4 birds on the ground. How many birds are there in all?

17. Maya drew 3 stars, 8 hearts, and 5 circles. How many shapes did she draw in all?

18. A store has 4 red hats, 3 blue hats, and 6 green hats. How many hats does the store have in all?

19. Leo has 5 pennies in his pocket, 7 pennies in his piggy bank, and 3 pennies on his desk. How many pennies does he have in all?

20. There are 4 boys and 6 girls playing soccer, and 5 children watching. How many children are there in all?

21. Sophie planted 3 rose bushes, 4 sunflower plants, and 5 tulip plants in her garden. How many plants did she plant in all?

22. A box has 6 crayons, 5 markers, and 4 colored pencils. How many art supplies are in the box in all?
