6. A chef uses 6 cups of flour for each batch of bread. If the chef used 42 cups of flour in one week, how many batches of bread did the chef make?

7. A baker puts 18 muffins into 9 boxes with the same number in each. How many muffins per box?

8. A rectangular garden has a length of 13 feet. If the area of the garden is 91 square feet, what is the width of the garden?

9. A store received 629 muffins on Monday and 887 muffins on Tuesday. How many muffins did it receive?

10. Grace baked 554 muffins and the family ate 216 of them. How many muffins are left?
